We offer inpatient treatment for adolescents who have acute psychiatric symptoms. Our philosophy of care embraces a comprehensive treatment model to help individuals get well.

We provide a therapeutic environment for adolescents with:

- Suicidal ideation
- Psychotic symptoms
- Impulsivity with marked risk-taking and dangerous behaviors
- Serious non-suicidal, self-injurious acts
- Inability to self-regulate mood and/or emotions
- Severe and persistent anxiety and/or panic attacks
- Disruptive behaviors

Our treatment team delivers evidence-based, individualized care to help teens and their families develop positive adaptive coping skills to help them overcome and successfully navigate everyday stressors.

Our Approach:

- Each teen works with an individualized treatment team to create a plan of care to promote healing and recovery.
- Programming can include group, individual and family therapy and can help teens develop new coping skills and gain support through interactions with peers facing similar issues.
- A full-time special education teacher provides academic instruction during the school year.
